Metro Health emergency room is staffed with full-time, residency-trained physicians. There are 24/7 in-house intensivists and laborists.

Metro Health has AOA accreditation for all of the residency programs and has Initial Accreditation as a Sponsoring Institution with the ACMGE (Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education). The Orthopedic Surgery Program, Obstetrics & Gynecology Program, Family Medicine, Internal Medicine, Emergency Medicine, Sports Medicine Fellowship and General Surgery Program have Initial Accreditation with the ACGME and Urology is in pre-accreditation status with ACGME as well. The Family Medicine, General Surgery and Obstetrics & Gynecology Programs have Osteopathic Recognition with the ACGME and Internal Medicine's application has been submitted to the Review Committee.

Metro Health Medical Education Program Offers:

- Clinical clerkships
- Residency programs in emergency medicine, orthopedics, family practice and family practice/neuromusculoskeletal medicine, general surgery, internal medicine, obstetrics and gynecology, and urology.
- Ambulatory-care teaching clinics in family practice, obstetrics/gynecology, internal medicine, surgery, orthopaedic surgery, osteopathic manipulative medicine, and urology with over 25,000 visits per year.
- Statewide Campus System of Michigan State University College of Osteopathic Medicine educational day programs in emergency medicine, otolaryngology /facial plastic surgery, orthopedics, family practice, internal medicine, obstetrics and gynecology, general surgery, and urology.
