Opioid Crisis Initiatives

In response to the opioid crisis in our region, recent legislative changes have been made. There are a variety of initiatives that Metro Health – University of Michigan Health is taking to comply with these new laws, including the addition of community resources for substance abuse on discharge instructions, or After Visit Summaries. This information will be available for patients that have been treated for an overdose.

Please note, this is not mandated for individuals with a history of overdose or who have an opioid prescription, only for patients that are treated for an overdose.
